MARY'S MEALS (NTH BRANCH)

– acknowledges the fantastic support we received in our 2025 fundraiser: Walk to Knock, Cycle through South & West Tipp, 22k swim in Lough Derg. These efforts raised €25,848 which will feed over 1150 children. €22 provides a child with one meal a day in a place of education for an entire school year. Nationally 7 walks to Knock took place which raised €282,000. MM Ireland raises €2.3million annually while MM International operates a budget of £50 million which allows us to feed over 3 million children in the poorest countries in the world. 97% of all your donations reach its target. There are 80,000 volunteers feeding 1.2 million children in Malawi. The actor Liam Neeson visited south Sudan last week where 7.7 million people are suffering malnutrition and of these 2.3 million are children. He added “the world cannot turn its back on children like those I met in South Sudan”. We are delighted that with your support we are able to feed so many children but we are aware that there are millions more children to be fed and educated. There is so much more we have to do.
