# World Day of the Poor Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> November 2025

"You, O Lord, are my hope" (*Ps* 71:5). These words well up from a heart burdened by grave hardship:

"You have made me see many troubles and calamities" (v. 20), the Psalmist exclaims. At the same time, his heart remains open and confident; steadfast in faith, he acknowledges the support of God, whom he calls "a rock of refuge, a strong fortress" (v. 3).
