PARISH COLLECTIONS JAN – JUN 2026 – The Parish is required to pay €83,325 to the Diocesan Office for the targeted based collections. These include the Common Fund - €59,400, The Diocesan Services - €21,450 and Vocations & Priestly Development €2,475. The Non-Targeted based collections are the Peter's Pence, Propagation of the Faith, Trócaire, Holy Land and Emigrants collection. We return to Diocesan office what is received from these collections. Grateful thanks to all who support the collections through the year and enable the parish to meet its targets and maintain churches and houses and the costs of insurance – light & heat and wages. You are encouraged to use the weekly envelope – (we record the amount) and so able to reclaim the rebate from revenue for annual amounts over €250 – using the CHY3 form.
